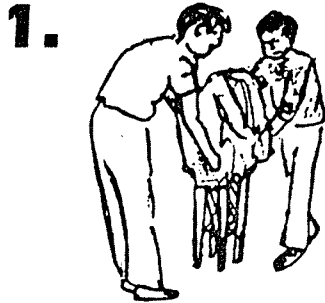


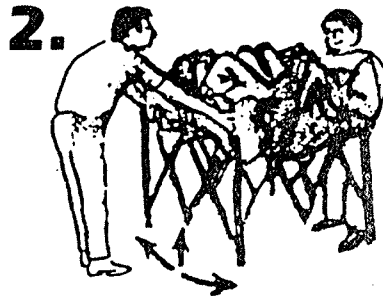


# HOW TO SET-UP YOUR SHELTER

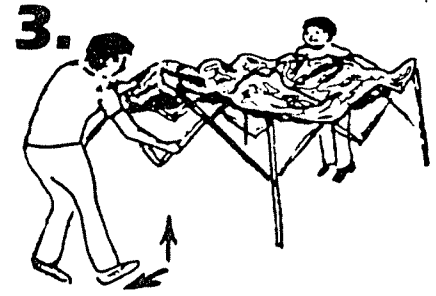
PLEASE READ EACH STEP BEFORE YOU ATTEMPT SET-UP



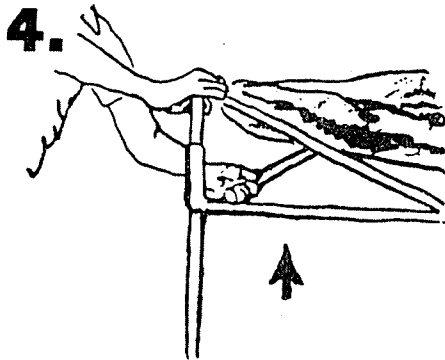
**1.** Remove cover. Place shelter in center of clear area. With two people standing at opposite sides, grasp in each hand the center portion of the square outer legs.



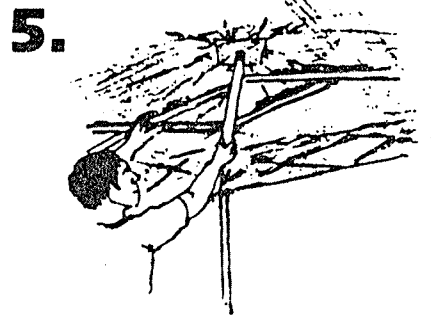
**2.** Lift upward and, at the same time, spread arms to fullest extent outward. Set shelter down.



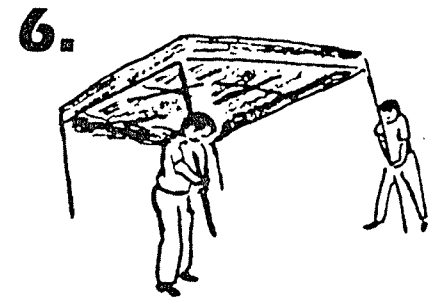
**3.** Now, position yourselves opposite each other on the sides of the shelter that are supported by a truss assembly running to the center. (This is very important! Pulling on the unsupported sides may cause damage to the frame). Grasp the center diamond shaped truss with two hands. At the same time, lift upward and step backward as the shelter unfolds.



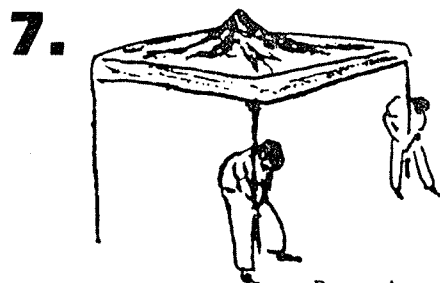
**4.** **CORNER LOCKING:** Pull up the valance fabric at each corner. Place palm of one hand on top . . . with the thumb of the hand, depress the corner snap button located at the inside. With your free hand, lift upward on the slider assembly until it locks in place. Continue this same operation for each corner.



**5.** **CENTER PEAK ADJUSTMENT:** With the plastic cap pointing up, raise the center peak and place the post in the retaining cup.



**6.** **FULL HEIGHT ADJUSTMENT:** Stand at two adjacent corners. Tilt the shelter up. Grasp square inner leg and pull downward. Once the snap button is free, depress and set it in place.



**7.** Repeat the same procedure for the other side.

TO TAKE DOWN SHELTER,  
SIMPLY REVERSE THE STEPS SHOWN

## IMPORTANT

**MODERATE WIND** - Use E-Z Up Stake Kit  
**RAIN OR HEAVY WIND** - Take Shelter Down  
**WET FABRIC** - Let Shelter Fabric Dry Before Closing  
**STORAGE** - Use Storage Bag when shelter is not in use
